

Doddington Park Early Years Entitlements Offer

Dear Parent/Carer

We offer up to 15 or 30 hours per week funded childcare for eligible families, subject to availability. Children are admitted on a first come first served basis.

Funded Childcare offers:

- Up to 15 hours per week Early Learning for Two Year Olds (EL2) for families in receipt of additional support. Maximum entitlement of 570 per academic year.
- Up to 15 hours per week of Universal funded childcare for children from 3 years old until school age. Maximum entitlement of 570 per academic year.
- Up to 30 hours per week of funded childcare for eligible working parents from 9 months. Maximum entitlement of 1140 per academic year.

Funded childcare is available **from the term after** the child reaches the age of eligibility (with a valid code).

How do we deliver funded childcare at Papermoon Nursery:

Option 1: Standard (38 weeks term time)

This option is for children accessing EL2 or Universal funding at age 3.

Your child can access up to 15 hours per week.

Sessions are available between 8am-1pm and 1pm-6pm.

Option 2: Stretched (51 weeks per year)

This option is for working parents, eligible for up to 30 hours per week. At Papermoon, we stretch your funding over 51 weeks of the year. This gives working parents added flexibility for childcare all year round and covers most school holidays (less bank holidays), giving you peace of mind that we've got you covered when you need us most. This means that your child can access up to 22.35 hours per week funded childcare throughout the year, which still adds up to 1140 hours over the year to maximise your full government entitlement.

Sessions are available between 8am-1pm and 1pm-6pm*

*Please note that as our sessions are in 5 or 10 hour blocks, if parents want to access any additional sessions, we are happy to deduct the residual 2.35 hours off the cost of any purchased sessions to ensure you have used up all our allowance although parents are under no obligation to do so.

Notice Period

Four weeks notice is required to terminate your contract or change your booking pattern (including meals).

Registration Fee

A non-refundable registration fee of £50 is charged for private services (additional hours and meals). This is not charged to children accessing only their EYE.
